

## Job Description: FIBRE SURVEYOR (CONTRACT)

### Place of Work:

Predominantly site based with some desktop reporting work – nationwide but generally tends to be regional depending on work allocation from our expanding Client base. Travel to and from site is an integral part of the job. Initial allocation based in Coventry and Huddersfield (to be confirmed, and subject to change).

### Roles and Responsibilities:

Surveyors available for contract work with practical experience in FTTH network infrastructure surveying with all appropriate training/certification. Own van, tools & equipment preferable. PPE and signage will be provided by 4site.

Need to be flexible, proactive and well disciplined.

1. Adhere to Client specific procedures and specification.
2. Carry out dynamic risk assessments on site prior to work commencing and report any visible hazards or defects from site by way of a "red flag" early warning system.
3. Implement control measures as required to enable the survey to be completed in a safe manner.
4. Accurately record all existing site information and propose the most practical & cost-effective solution based on client specification and any known constraints.
5. Validate the Client HLD (high level design) and note any issues/dependencies.
6. Act responsibly when attending any survey and protect the interests of both 4Site and the Customer always.
7. Be professional, safety conscious and conscientious at all times both on and off site.
8. Liaise with all those involved on site at survey including local authority representatives, landlords, council officials and any other 3<sup>rd</sup> party.
9. Collate the information gathered in a concise & legible manner incl. survey notes, sketches, photos and present it clearly for submission to the Client.

10. Compile all project specific reports and associated documentation with a strong focus on quality, deadlines and deliverables.
11. Liaise with and update the 4site FTTH PM.
12. Escalate any issues or blockers immediately and provide support as required.
13. Assist with resolving any queries to enable design to progress as quickly as possible.
14. Comply with company policies/procedures without exception.
15. Adhere to mandatory Health & Safety legislation without exception.

### Experience and Qualifications:

- 5 years + in a similar challenging work environment
- Preferably with underground and overhead experience, incl. BTOR
- Underground; jointing, rodding/roping experience useful but not essential
- Overhead; experience of poling, providing connections to customers houses as well as maintaining and surveying existing poles and connections useful but not essential
- Knowledge and experience of trenching, ducting, cabling, poling, earthing etc.
- PC Literate (proficient in MS Office) with good reporting and communication skills
- A good practical knowledge of all current safety legislation associated with underground and overhead work e.g. HSG47 Avoiding danger from underground services and GS6 Avoiding danger from overhead power lines (UK) or the Irish equivalent.
- A good understanding of NRSWA and reinstatement
